

[Manufacturer] Certification of REACH Compliance
For Tyres Sold in the European Union

The European Union REACH Regulation 1907/2006 imposes restrictions on the marketing and use of certain “extender oils” for the production of tyres placed on the EU market. In particular, REACH prohibits use of extender oils that have high levels of dangerous polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH). The EU ban on use of high-PAH oils for tyre production covers all brands, types and sizes of tyres, whether manufactured within the EU or imported.

manufacturer of tyres, hereby certifies that all of the tyres for the European market¹ and all components of each tyre subject to above regulation:

- manufactured after 1 January 2010 (DOT 0110),
- which are supplied to at least one of the Member States of the European Union,

fully comply with the mandatory technical and marketing restrictions set out in Entry 50 of Annex XVII of REACH Regulation 1907/2006.

In accordance with REACH, this Certification of compliance has been ensured through:

- analysis of PAH content by suitable test method (such as IP346) of the extender oil used for the manufacture of the tyre and all of its components;

or

- analysis according to ISO 21461 of the vulcanized rubber of each tyre component demonstrating that the limit of 0,35% bay proton is not exceeded.

For confidentiality reasons none of the above documents may be released to third parties but can be provided to authorities upon request.
