Brussels, 23 November 2012 - ETRMA acknowledges the decision of Nokian Tyres to withdraw its ice and snow labelling sticker launched in Sweden, Norway and Finland. The Nokian Tyres' statement, dated 22 November 2012, asks its retailers to "immediately cease all use of Nokian Tyres' winter grip stickers".

ETRMA and all its members have long committed to developing a proper consumer information on ice and snow as soon as a robust and reliable test method is available; industry will continue pursuing this objective.
