Brussels - January, 26th 2015, took place the official signature of the European platform ERRLAB. ERRLAB which means European Research and Rubber Laboratories is a European informal network of laboratories for research and testing in rubber applications, established by France, Germany and Italy benchmark rubber laboratories (LRCCP, DIK, CERISIE respectively), with the support of the rubber industry National Associations (SNCP, WDK, Assogomma respectively) and the European Tyre and Rubber Manufacturers Association (ETRMA). More than 100 doctors, engineers and technicians highly rubber specialized are committed.

ERRLAB objective is to share resources and expertise in order to provide an ever better and complete technical service to the European rubber manufacturing industry, with a special attention to small and medium enterprises, in the field of Environment, Health and Safety studies, Research & Development, testing and certification.
